Best New Looks for Lighting Up the Yard • You might never guess that these five sleek pieces are intended for exterior illumination. Clockwise from top right: CL Sterling & Son tempers the industrial chic of its hanging aluminum *Garden shade* with a splash of orange enamel (through designers; 860/434-3744). Foscarini has taken its popular polyethylene *Havana* floor lamp and created an all-weather outdoor version that is nearly invincible (67" h, \$582; YLighting.com). Easy to wire for outdoor use, NotNeutral's metal *Season* lantern creates a festive atmosphere with its pinhole, Moroccan-inspired design (large, \$180; NotNeutral.com). Topped with a shade made from weather-resistant Sunbrella fabric, the brass framework of Richard Frinier's *Shoji* table lantern for Currey & Company will acquire a lovely patina with age (\$1,060; CurreyCo.com). The graphic high-gloss lacquer base of Serralunga's *Lady Mary* polyethylene floor lamp, designed by Marc Sadler, provides an intriguing contrast to the softly etched diffuser (about 87" h, \$2,315; 800/611-4664). — Katherine E.
