Fast-forward 35 years and you'll find Knibb, now an internationally celebrated landscape designer, presiding over **1524**, his brand-new showroom on Abbot Kinney Boulevard. The store carries contemporary lighting fixtures by C L Sterling & Son as well as Knibb's inaugural indoor/outdoor furnishings line, SK1, which is made entirely with reclaimed wood. Also available is the ingenious Knibb Modular Garden, a selection of predesigned eco-friendly landscapes featuring pavers, low-maintenance grasses, trees and flowers. The gardens are sold by the square foot and go from selection to installation in less than six weeks.
